Isodine® Ointment

The active ingredient "povidone iodine" of Isodine® Ointment is a bactericidal disinfectant that is used around the world. It exerts excellent sterilization/disinfection effects on various bacteria and viruses in a short time. It exerts an excellent effect in sterilizing or disinfecting affected areas such as cuts, grazes and burns.

Characteristics

- Isodine® Ointment exerts a rapid effect in sterilizing or disinfecting a wide range of microorganisms such as various bacteria, fungi and viruses.
- This product is less irritating and is thus suitable for disinfection of skin.
- The color of Isodine shows disinfected areas, which prevents some areas from being left not disinfected. In addition, ointment on clothes can be washed off easily with water.



Precautions

Never do

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions are more likely to occur.)

Anyone who has had allergic symptoms to this product or any of the ingredients of the product should not use this medication.

Consultation

1. The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson for a consultation before use.

- (1) Persons undergoing medical treatment from a physician.
- (2) Persons have a history of allergic symptoms induced by drugs, etc.
- (3) The affected area is widespread.
- (4) Persons have a deep wound or severe burn.

2. In the case where any of the following symptoms appears after using this product, since there is a possibility of adverse reactions, immediately stop using this product and consult a physician, a pharmacist, or a registered salesclerk, bringing this package insert.

Affected site	Symptoms
Skin	Rash/redness, itching

The following serious symptoms may rarely appear. In such case, immediately consult a physician.

Name of Symptom	Symptoms
Shock (Anaphylaxis)	Immediately after using this product, symptoms such as itchy skin, hives, hoarseness, sneezing, itchy throat, respiratory distress, palpitation, or clouding of consciousness may occur.

3. In the case where symptoms do not improve despite use of this product for 5 to 6 days, stop using this product and consult a physician, a pharmacist, or a registered salesclerk, bringing this package insert.

Indications

Sterilization/disinfection of affected areas such as cuts, stab wounds, grazes, blisters on foot and burns

Dosage and Administration

Apply an appropriate amount to affected areas several times a day

<Precautions related to Dosage and Administration>

- Strictly follow the Dosage and Administration.
- When allowing children to use this product, a guardian must be present to watch and tell how to use it.
- Take care so that this product does not get into the eyes. Should it get into the eyes, immediately rinse them with water or lukewarm water and see an ophthalmologist if you develop a severe irritation.
- This product is only for external use; do not ingest or use for gargling or sterilization/disinfection of mucosa.

Dosage and Administration

Each g of this product contains 100 mg of povidone iodine (available iodine 10 mg).

As additives, this product contains macrogol and pH adjuster.

Precautions for storage and handling

- (1) Seal tightly and store in a cool place avoiding direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer to a different container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality.)
- (4) Pay attention to coloring when it comes into contact with clothes, etc. Immediately wash it off with water in this case.
- (5) Do not use this product after the expiration date.
